Chairs Report led by Marj Bridger and Christina Sachanowicz

- QSP Wrap Up: Very successful campaign raising \$11,890.
- Math Club New Updates: Grades 2-6 were rolled out this year, with coordinator also organizing Math night and a Grade 1 workshop (which was

held 2 weeks ago). There will be a Math and Memory summer camp, with notification going out to parents next week.

- Sacramental Lunch Update: Lunch was held May 22/19, thoroughly enjoyed by students, and came in on budget. For next year Fr. Sean has suggested that mass should be held beforehand, which all agree will make this so much more special.
- Activity Fee Timeline Request: As other priorities have gotten in the way - Jen will pick this back up in early September.
- Cooling A/C Update: Update from Trustee Markus DeDomenico provided to Christina as follows:
 - ➔ Solar film was installed on all the glass in the atrium of the front hall. It was checked with head of maintenance and the result was very good. There was a significant reduction in heat compared to areas without the film. Therefore Mr. De Domenico has requested that the film be installed in all three floors of the south facing windows in the stairway areas, which will reduce the heat in the building. Crews are measuring the library for the cooling centre installation. St. Gregory is in phase 1 of a four phase rollout. The thinking is that cooling centre will be done by mid summer, but Mr. De Domenico will confirm.
